KEEPING UP WITH CHANGE

Admission standards for OMPT Fellowship Programs will be changing January 1, 2020.

How does this effect those interested in completing an Orthopedic Manual Therapy Fellowship?

- After January 1, 2020, you must be Board Certified in Orthopedics / Sports in order to be eligible for Fellowship training.
- After January 1, 2020, you must be a graduate of an accredited residency program in order to be eligible for Fellowship training.
- After January 1, 2020, certification and pre-fellowship are no longer options in qualification for Fellowship training.

What options will IAR provide to meet these new standards?

ABPTRFE ACCREDITED ORTHOPEDIC RESIDENCY

- 13 month part - time structure
- Didactics completed 1 weekend / month
- Weekly assignments
- 150 hours of mentoring with your preferred clinician
- Live and work where you would like
- Make your market salary
- Sit for OCS upon completion

SPORTS MANUAL THERAPY CERTIFICATION (SMTC)

- Qualifies for Fellowship entrance prior to January 1, 2020
- Earn your SMTC in 1 weekend, enter Fellowship anytime before Jan 1, 2020

CERTIFICATION IN SPORTS & ORTHOPEDIC MANUAL THERAPY (CSOMT)

- Course schedule is **integrated** into the IAR Orthopedic Residency
- No formal mentoring required
- Additional assessment of competencies must be completed to earn CSOMT prior to January 1, 2020
